Transfer date

1. Agreement to Purchase. The Buyer agrees to purchase the rabbit identified above from Heart Hopper Giants. Ownership transfers only after the full purchase price is paid and the rabbit is physically delivered to or picked up by the Buyer.

2. Refundable Deposit. If the Buyer cancels before transfer, the deposit will be refunded. After transfer, amounts paid are governed by the health-guarantee and return terms below. A refund may be returned through the original payment method or another method agreed to in writing.

3. Pickup and Delivery. The Buyer is responsible for arriving at the agreed time with a secure carrier. Any delivery charge will be stated and accepted before delivery. A delayed transfer date must be approved by Heart Hopper Giants.

60-Day Limited Health Guarantee

4. Health at Transfer. Heart Hopper Giants represents that, to the best of the Breeder's knowledge, the rabbit is in good health and free of known contagious illness at transfer. Known observations or conditions must be written in the disclosure section of this agreement.

5. Guarantee Period. The limited health guarantee begins on the transfer date and continues for 60 calendar days. A claim must be reported promptly in writing and supported by records from a licensed veterinarian who examined the rabbit during the guarantee period.

6. Covered Conditions. The guarantee applies to a serious congenital, hereditary, or pre-existing condition that a veterinarian determines was present at transfer and that materially affects the rabbit's health or expected quality of life.

7. Excluded Conditions. The guarantee does not cover injury, accident, improper housing, heat exposure, toxic exposure, neglect, failure to provide food or water, sudden diet changes, exposure to other animals or contagious disease after transfer, parasites acquired after transfer, elective treatment, or conditions caused or worsened by failure to obtain timely veterinary care.

8. Remedy. For a verified covered condition, Heart Hopper Giants and the Buyer will agree in writing to either a refund of the rabbit's purchase price or a replacement rabbit when one is available. The maximum remedy is the amount paid for the rabbit. Veterinary, travel, delivery, and other expenses are not reimbursed unless Heart Hopper Giants approved them in writing before they were incurred.

9. Urgent Care. This agreement does not replace veterinary care. The Buyer must seek prompt veterinary attention for refusal to eat or drink, lack of stool, breathing difficulty, severe lethargy, uncontrolled bleeding, suspected poisoning, injury, or other urgent symptoms.

Buyer Responsibilities

- Provide safe housing, appropriate flooring, protection from predators and weather, clean water, and a suitable Flemish Giant diet.
- Follow a gradual transition when changing food and monitor eating, drinking, stool, behavior, and weight.
- Keep the rabbit separate from unfamiliar rabbits until health and compatibility are established; rabbits must not be left together unsupervised until they are safely bonded.
- Obtain veterinary care from a rabbit-knowledgeable licensed veterinarian when illness or injury is suspected.

- Comply with applicable animal-control, housing, and ownership laws.

Rehoming and Breeding

10. Responsible Rehoming. If the Buyer can no longer keep the rabbit, the Buyer may rehome it responsibly. The Buyer agrees not to abandon the rabbit and will make a good-faith effort to place it in a safe, suitable home. Heart Hopper Giants may be contacted for guidance, but is not required to accept the rabbit back or reimburse the Buyer.

11. Breeding Rights. Breeding rights are ☐ included ☐ not included ☐ subject to separate written terms. No pedigree, registration, or breeding outcome is guaranteed unless specifically stated in writing.

12. Adult Size and Temperament. The Buyer understands that future weight, body type, fertility, show results, and temperament cannot be guaranteed. Estimates may be based on age, development, and parentage, but each rabbit develops individually.
